# Residential Camps/ Entering 1st–6th Grade

## Otter Camp 1st-3rd

Experience a half-week introduction to overnight camping! This fast-paced camp allows campers to swim, boat, make crafts, and sing around the campfire in a safe, friendly environment. Leadership is experienced in helping first-time campers explore nature while learning about God and creating a Christian community.

Fee: \$180 Dates: July 14-16

## Beaver Camp 4th-6th

Explore Camp Brethren Heights for a week! Along with the activities during Otter Camp, campers will also get to do nature activities, service projects, and a “mystery” dinner.

Fee: \$370 Dates: July 20-25



# Residential Camps/ Entering 7th–12th Grade

## Bobcat Youth Camp 7th-12th

Broaden your horizons with Bobcat Camp! Additional activities for these more independent campers include an option to get even closer to nature by “mucking” through some of our wetlands at camp! Fee: \$370 Dates: June 15-20



# Eco Camps/ Entering 7th-9th Grade

## Survivor Camp (7th-9th)

Connect with God and God's Creation at Camp Alexander Mack in Milford, Indiana! At Survivor Camp, you can sleep outside in tents, build natural shelters, purify water, gather wild food, play awareness games, and learn navigation skills. Survivor Camp will include campers from Michigan's Camp Brethren Heights, Illinois's Camp Emmaus, and Indiana's Camp Alexander Mack. Camp Brethren Heights will provide transportation to Indiana for Michigan campers.

Fee: \$390 Dates: July 6-12  
Maximum 15 CBH Campers



# Family Camps

## Family/Grand Camp

Campers of all ages have fun at Family/Grand Camp! Grandparents and grandchildren can choose to spend a weekend together or you can come with the whole family. Play games, take hikes, play four square, and worship together, similar to our other summer camps. This is a great opportunity to enjoy camp with family, away from the distractions of busy schedules.

Fee: \$250 Per Family Group

Dates: August 3-5



# How to Register

1. Visit [cambrethrenheightsmi.org](http://cambrethrenheightsmi.org) and click on the Navigation Bar where it says Summer Camps.
2. Click on the Register Now button near the camp you are signing up for. You can also use the QR codes in this booklet.
3. This will take you to the Cheddar Up webpage, where you can sign up for the camp using online registration.
4. Enter your name (the person signing up the camper) and your email address in the corresponding boxes. Then press the orange Enter Button to continue.
5. Scroll to the bottom and add payment for your selected camp to the cart. This is where you can choose between paying the \$50 non-refundable deposit or the full Camp fee. Click the blue Add to Cart button on the one you choose and enter your camper's first and last name. Press the orange Continue button.
6. Proceed to complete the Camper Registration/Health Form. If your camper is attending Survivor Camp, you must complete the Travel Camp and Off-site Activity Release. If you need a campership, fill out the campership (camp scholarship) form as well. Then press the orange Continue button.

# How to Register

7. Here, you can choose how you will be paying the camp fee (credit card, e-check, cash, check). This is also the point where you can choose to make an account to use for sign ups in the future. You can apply a promo code if applicable (see page 10). Checks are to be made out to Camp Brethren Heights Inc.
8. Please submit the \$50 deposit (non-refundable unless the camp is canceled) and your completed Camper Registration/Health Form by **June 1st for Residential and Eco Camps**.
9. If you are submitting a deposit, the remaining balance can be paid by clicking the Summer Camp Payments button by your selected camp on the Summer Camp section on our website. Alternatively, you may use the link, <https://givebutter.com/W1OkFS>, or the QR code below. Be sure to add a note mentioning which registered camper(s) the payment is for.



# Before Coming to Camp

## Before Coming to Camp

Two weeks before your camp, we will send you a confirmation email indicating the following: **balance due (if any), camper and parent information, and check-in procedures.** It would be ideal to have your full payment paid before arriving at camp to help the process go more smoothly. # Discounts & Camperships

## Multiple Children Discount

A discount is available when sending multiple children from the same family to Residential and Eco Camps. For each additional child, you get to take \$50 off that child's camp cost. Please note this on your registration form. (Example: Child 1: \$370, Child 2:\$320, Child 3: \$320, Etc.) At checkout use the code: Siblings2025

## Bring a Friend

Save money by bringing a friend who has never been to Camp Brethren Heights! By bringing a friend and noting it on your registration form, you will each receive a \$50 discount. This does not apply to siblings. At checkout use the code: Friends2025

## Camperships (Camp Scholarships)

We believe that no child should miss out on camp because of financial barriers. If your camper is in need of financial assistance to attend Camp Brethren Heights, we have funds set aside for partial or full camperships.

Camperships are granted on a first-come, first-served basis. When registering a camper fill out the Campership Application. It is included with the other forms. At checkout use the code Scholarship with the amount needed for your camper to go to camp. Scholarship are awarded in \$10 increments, so the amount must end in a zero (ex: Scholarship150 for a \$150 campership).

A email will inform families of granted campership requests.
